# SUMMIT CLASSROOM PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES & REGISTRATION FORM

**Refund Policy:** Students who register for the class but withdraw prior to the start of the first session will receive a full refund of the program price. Students who withdraw after the first session but prior to the start of the second session will receive a refund of the program price, minus \$100. Students who withdraw after the second session but prior to the start of the third session will receive a refund of the program price, minus \$150. No refund will be granted once the third session begins. Please note that you must contact the Summit office directly to withdraw from the program. Refunds will be based on the date of the call and not on the number of sessions the student has actually attended.

**Behavior Policy:** All students enrolled in a Summit course must maintain appropriate behavior at all times. Students must adhere to all school rules and regulations, respect their classmates and teachers, and contribute to a positive learning environment. Summit will not provide refunds to students expelled for behavioral reasons.

**Extended Time:** Students who have received approved extended time on the test from The College Board or ACT, Inc. should contact the Summit Office to discuss the possibility of alternate accommodations. Please call us at 1-800-MYTUTOR (800-698-8867)

**Attendance/Make-Up Sessions:** The schedule of classes has been pre-arranged with the host location. Students are required to attend each session. If a student must miss a practice test session, we will mail the test home for the student to complete. For more information on making up missed content, log in to our online portal following the missed class to read instructors' notes, or speak with the class instructor(s) directly. Summit will not offer makeup classes for missed lessons.

**Class Cancellations:** If classes are cancelled at the school, our classes will also be cancelled. School cancellations will be announced by the school. Summit will email parents and students of a class cancellation as soon as we have that information. The class will be made up at the next available opportunity.

**Materials:** Students are responsible for bringing supplies for personal use, such as pencils and calculators. Summit will provide all other course materials. Course materials will be distributed to students during the first instructional session of the class.

**Score Increase Commitment:** We are confident that you will not find a more effective test preparation program, and we are willing to put our results up against those of any of our competitors. Should a student not realize an increase\* in his or her combined score following the completion of the Summit program, please contact us to discuss next steps. Please keep in mind, to obtain the most from the class students should attend all classes and complete all assigned work.

\*Score Increase is calculated as follows: Starting score must be from most recent official test taken prior to our program. Finishing score must be from the first official test offered following the completion of our program.

## FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Students who receive financial assistance from their school are eligible to receive a discount off the cost of the Summit course. Summit will match the percentage of financial aid offered by the school to students less a minimum payment of \$250.
