

The following information was sent to parents via email by Principal Sue Petrone on Wednesday, January 5, 2021.

Remote Access to Classes:

Given that we have a number of students out of school either recovering from COVID or having to quarantine due to a close COVID contact, our IT staff has installed the appropriate software on our faculty's computers so that students may Zoom into classes and observe/hear what is going on in the classroom. Zooming into classes is not required and please keep the health of the student at the forefront of any decision to join a class.

Teachers will create a Zoom link for the class and will admit students at the beginning of class. Because teachers will not be checking emails during class, students need to sign in as the class begins and will not be admitted during the class period. This arrangement is being offered to help the students who *must* be at home so that they can stay current with what is going on in the classroom. We do not feel that it should be seen as a substitute for in-person instruction. All assessments will be taken in-person when a student returns to school and students will not be penalized for taking those assessments at a later date.
